for free services through *Women's Way*.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

A woman is eligible for Women's Way if she:

- Lives in North Dakota
- Is 40-64 years old
- Has no insurance
- Has insurance that doesn't cover Pap tests or mammograms
- Has insurance, but can't afford to pay deductible or co-pay
- Is not enrolled or eligible for Medicare Part B or Medicaid
- Meets the income guidelines
- Is 21-39 years old and

*o has not had a Pap test in the last 3-5 years, or
o needs breast or cervical diagnostic follow-up, or
o has breast symptoms, or
o is at high risk for breast cancer*

WHAT DOES WOMEN'S WAY PAY FOR?

- Office visits that pertain to breast or cervical cancer screening or diagnostic services
- Pap test
- HPV test
- Mammogram
- Breast MRI
- Breast cyst aspiration
- Diagnostic mammogram
- Breast ultrasound
- Breast or cervical biopsy
- Colposcopy
- Pathology
- Surgical consults and second opinions

Women's Way reimburses for services at the Medicare Part B Rate.

If a client requires treatment, Women's Way does not pay for treatment services.

A Medicaid Treatment Program is available to pay for treatment of breast and cervical cancer or pre-cancerous conditions for uninsured eligible women enrolled in Women's Way.
